Scottish Landlord Register

Landlord registration (LLR) – introduced by the Antisocial Behaviour etc. (Scotland) Act 2004 (came into force April 2006)

Original purpose – to require local authorities to keep a register of individuals and organisations, who have been assessed as being 'fit and proper' to let houses

The register is accessible by members of the public

Registration typically last for three years.

Agent Acts on behalf of the Landlord (family member,

trustee, power of attorney)

Letting Agent Carries out work for a private landlord, manages

the property

Property Property that the landlord is renting out





Properties - Joint Owners










Property Ownership Individuals (Joint owners)






Registration types
