Background



We will ask people across Scotland what they think about the **inspection** of **social care** services.

Inspection means looking closely at something.



Social care is services that support people with daily living so they can be as independent as possible.



We will be asking people what they think from 24 October to 23 December 2022.



The Independent Review of Inspection, Scrutiny and Regulation (IRISR) was announced on 23 September.

A **review** is when something is looked at to see if it is working well and what needs to change.



The review will make **recommendations** to make sure that social care support services are the best they can be for people who get and give services.

A **recommendation** is what we think should happen.



IRISR will work to make sure human rights and being person-centred is at the centre of the inspection of social care.

The review will decide how inspection can be done across services that work together.



We are having a ‘Call for Evidence’ where you can share your written views on how inspection and rules can make sure social care support services can get better.



Your views are very important.

They will make sure the review works well.
