MEMORANDUM

The Official and Staff Sides of PNB have reached agreement on a pay award for police officers, as set out in PNB circular 2018/04. The revised rates for allowances are as follows:

Dog Handlers Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the Dog Handlers Allowance is set at £2,387.

Plain Clothes Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the Plain Clothes Allowance is set at £14.40.

On-call Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the On-call Allowance is set at £25.49.

Excessive Rest Day Disruption Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the Excessive Rest Day Disruption Allowance is set at £20.24.

Overnight Disruption Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the Overnight Disruption Allowance is set at £63.90.

Additional Disruption Allowance

With effect from 1 September 2018 the Additional Disruption Allowance is set at £42.60.

Minimum Standards Allowance

With effect from 1 April 2020 the Minimum Standards Allowance will be set at £95.85.
