The Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) published updated UK Government tax revenue and social security expenditure forecasts on November 25. These forecasts inform the provisional Block Grant Adjustments (BGAs) for the Scottish Budget 2021-22. Table A in the annex to this letter sets out the BGAs for Income Tax, Land and Buildings Transaction Tax (LBTT), Scottish Landfill Tax (SLfT), and the devolved Social Security benefits.

As you will be aware, the Scottish Budget is based on provisional Block Grant Adjustments where it takes place before the UK Budget. The UK Government has agreed, as with the Scottish Budget 2020-21, that the Scottish Government can choose to use the updated BGAs that will be provided alongside the UK Budget (date tbc) should it wish.

As you know, these BGA figures only provided half of the story as the full impact on Scotland's Budget will not be known until the SFC publish their forecasts in January.

The following additional points may also be of particular interest to the Committee.

In-year reconciliations to the 2020-21 Budget

The 2020-21 BGAs for the Fully Devolved Taxes and Social Security benefits have been updated to reflect the latest forecasts of corresponding tax receipts and social security expenditure in the rest of the UK. This update has resulted in the changes outlined to the 2020-21 BGAs at Table B in the Annex. To reflect these changes, a positive reconciliation of £149 million will be added to the 2020-21 Block Grant. As noted above, this only provides half of the story, and SFC forecasts alongside the Budget will allow a rounded picture of the net position.

Reconciliation to the 2021-22 Budget

There will be a -£318.7 million reconciliation to the 2021-22 Budget relating to 2018-19 Income Tax and the 2019-20 BGAs for LBTT, SLfT, Fines, Forfeitures and Fixed Penalties, and Carer's Allowance.

This is a small change of +£1.9 million, compared to the figure reported in our Fiscal Framework Outturn Report published in October 2020, reflecting the final outturn data for Fines, Forfeitures and Fixed Penalties. Final figures are provided in Table C.

I hope you have found this update helpful, and my officials would be happy to provide any further information on the block grant adjustments to Committee Members, as required.
