A clinical assessment has determined you no longer need to be in hospital

A multi-disciplinary team will assess your long term

needs, after discharge



You may need some time to recover before you go home Intermediate Care

can be provided in your own home, a care home or community hospital



you might need on-going community support when you go home or you may need to move into a

care home



your care provider will regularly review your care needs

and will adjust your care package, as required

### multi-disciplinary team

will include all the people involve a range of health and social care professionals...

They will talk to you about what help you might need on your return home



#### Intermediate Care



includes a range of different services all aimed at helping you stay independent and confident after your hospital stay

### community support

includes a range of different health and social care services, including -

home care, specialist nursing, and a range of third and independent sector services

#### care home

if you have very complex needs you may need to go into a care home. You will be able to choose which home you would like to stay in.



But sometimes you might need to make a temporary move to another home, just until your home of choice has a place for you.



you might be asked to contribute towards the cost of some community support services
