#### **Foot and Mouth Disease**

# Low risk – no change

In December, a small number of outbreaks of FMD serotype O were reported in Turkey (1), Algeria (3), Myanmar (3), FMD serotype SAT2 in South Africa (4), FMD serotype SAT3 in Namibia (2), and FMD serotype A in Myanmar (5).

### **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza**

### Low risk for wild bird incursion – no change

In December, a small number of outbreaks were reported in domestic poultry: HPAI H5N2 in Taiwan (7), HPAI H5N5 in Taiwan (2) and HPAI H5N8 in South Africa (3). In **Europe**, Poland reported outbreaks of HPAI H5N8 (3).

#### African Swine Fever

### Medium risk – no change

In December, in **Europe**, reported outbreaks of ASF have continued in backyard pig and commercial pig premises in Bulgaria (3), and Romania (57). Reports in wild boar continue in Belgium (1), Bulgaria (38), Estonia (3), Hungary (168), Italy (16), Latvia (27), Lithuania (29), Poland (336), Romania (71), and Slovakia (9). In **Asia**, China (1), and Indonesia (392) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. **Elsewhere**, there were outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs in Russia (1), and Moldova (1). ASF in wild boar has also been reported in Russia (14), Moldova (4), China (1) and South Korea (19).





### **Classical Swine Fever**

# Very low risk - no change

In December, Japan has reported an outbreak of CSF in domestic pigs (1) and a large number of cases in wild boar (109). Elsewhere, there were reports of CSF in Russia in wild boar (4).

# Bluetongue

# Low risk - no change

In December, there were reports of BTV-8 in Switzerland (1), and in Belgium (3), and BTV-16 in Greece (13). There were 181 reports of BTV-8 in France (dating from January 2019 – May 2019).


### **Newcastle disease**


# Low risk – no change

In December, there were outbreaks of ND in Dominican Republic (4), Russia (3), Romania (1) and USA (14).



















Classical swine fever disease in Japan from August 2019








Foot and Mouth Disease: April - December 2019
