- will ensure unrestricted access at any reasonable time to relevant premises and give any assistance to a British Sea Fishery Officer which they deem necessary, including the provision of information and documents relating to the landing, storage or sale of fisheries products;
- undertake to carry out auctions only during the hours notified to Fisheries Departments, unless prior authorisation has been given for alternative arrangements by a British Sea Fishery Officer;
- understand that designated status is contingent on the premises continuing to be approved/recognised by the relevant local authority for hygiene purposes;
- understand that Ministers or Department of Agriculture and Rural Development NI may publish details of designated auction sites/markets in any manner they see fit;
- understand that I/we must notify Fisheries Departments in writing of any change(s) to the information supplied in this application within 28 days of the change.
