


Paper 1 - Latest staffing and contact details for Scottish Government Homelessness Statistics Work

Scottish Government work on homelessness statistics has been part of the Communities Analysis Division for a number of years. This division is based within the ‘Directorate for Housing and Social Justice’, and covers analytical work on topics such as poverty and social justice, equality, social security, and housing, regeneration and planning.

Prior to July 2017, homelessness statistics was located within the ‘Social Security and Housing Access Statistics Unit’ of Communities Analysis Division. Following a restructuring of some divisional responsibilities in July 2017, **the homelessness statistics work has remained within the same division but has moved to the unit leading on housing and regeneration analysis**, which has subsequently been renamed to be the ‘**Housing, Homelessness and Regeneration Analysis Unit**’ (HHaRA).

This brings the homelessness statistics work into the unit that leads on a range of statistical, economic and social research work on areas such as affordable housing supply, new build statistics, social tenants and social housing statistics, private sector rent statistics, housing market analysis, and other related areas such as the Scottish Household Survey, the Scottish House Condition Survey, and work on measuring energy efficiency and housing quality.
