Title: Active Scotland Development Group : Note of meeting 1 workgroups

Purpose: This paper notes the comments made on whiteboards in the November meeting discussions on proposed workstreams.

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Group 1:

- Measure success (from baseline)
 - Need to map out Delivery Plan actions (and map out the money)
 - Explore link between national policy and local delivery
- To challenge, need to know what is out there and understand the links
 - Is there a need to map this by bringing local partners together?
 - Do we know what really works and scale it up, taking account of differences locally
 - Reframe to provide both challenge and support – to both policy and delivery
- Use existing structures and exploit
 - E.g. Role of CPPs
 - Connect with chairs/CEOs of CPPs, IJBs etc
 - Group should look again at statutory indicators (i.e number of visits to a leisure centre)
- Influence policy based on evidence
 - Assess impact locally

Group 2:

- Logic model – outcomes framework (evidence outcome)
 - Are these the right actions?
- Prioritise actions in the plan – what needs to happen?
- Key barriers/opportunities/challenges etc.
- Collaboration
- Go beyond the delivery plan
- Success
 - Influence work on the ground
 - Evidencing impact
 - Identify the gaps
