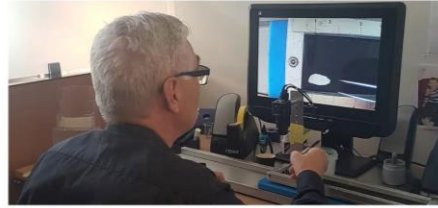




THE AZORES - TUNA FISHING

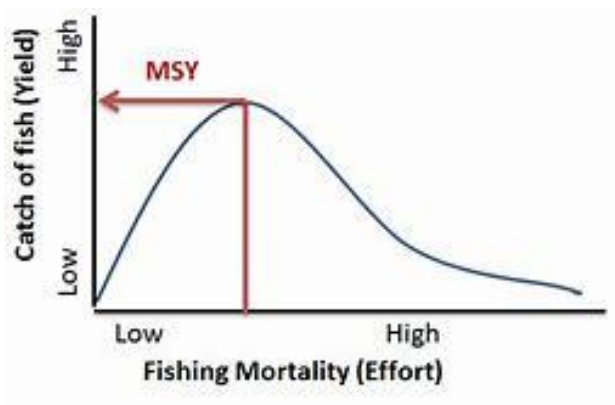
