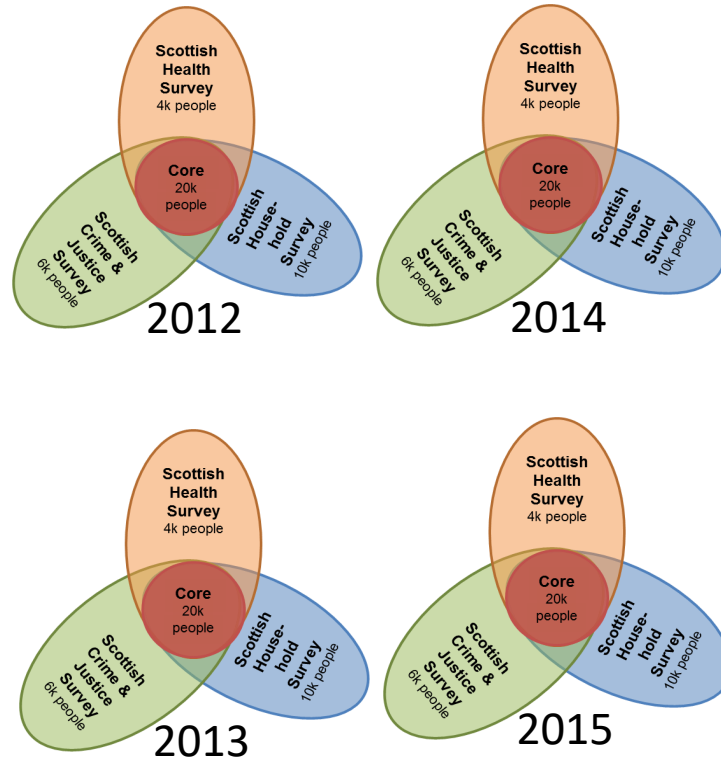

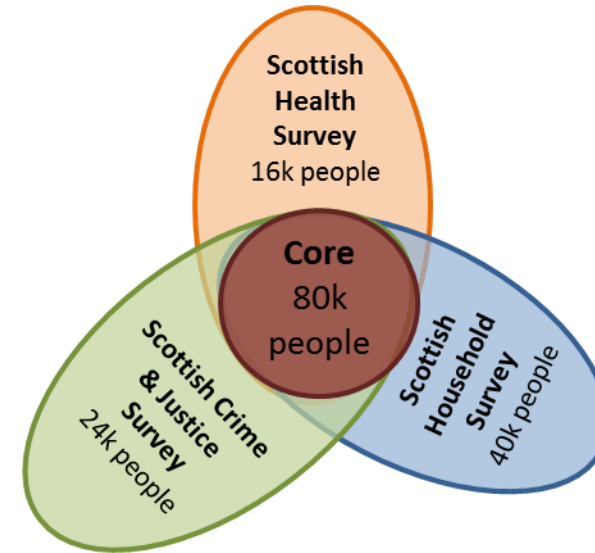

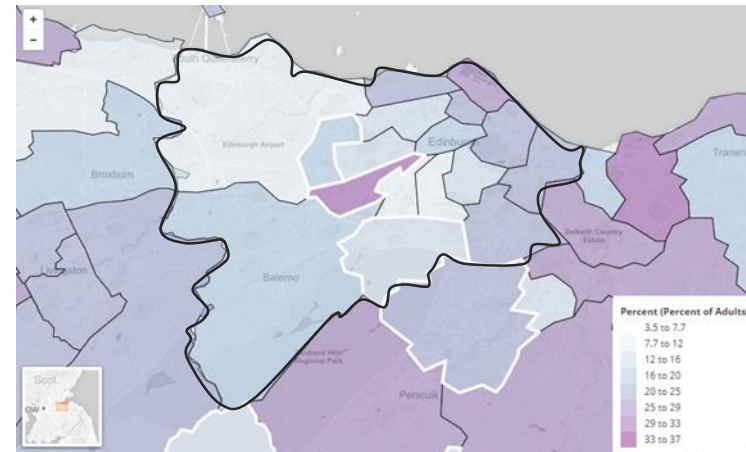
# What is Multiyear (MySSCQ)?



Analysis at electoral ward level

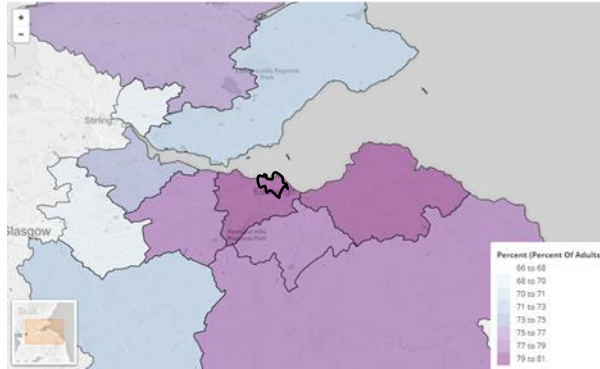


Smoking rates in City of Edinburgh

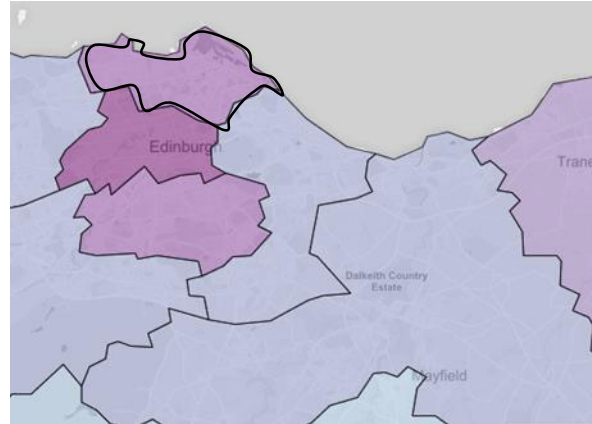

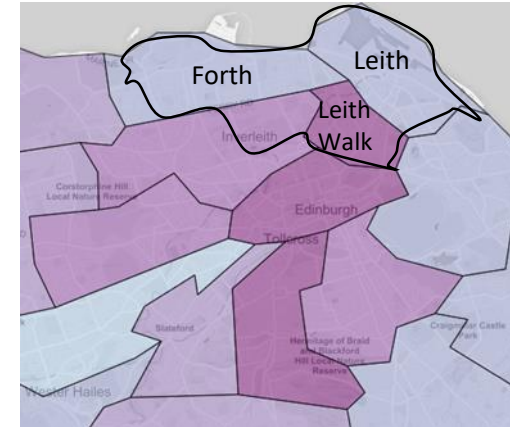
