

2,685,000 people were in employment in Scotland in Apr-Jun 2019, 131,000 more than in Apr-Jun 2008



Quarterly Labour Market Briefing – August 2019: Gender


The gender employment gap has decreased from 10.2 percentage points in 1999 to 5.8 percentage points in 2019







Quarterly Labour Market Briefing – August 2019: Youth employment and unemployment Scotland outperforms the UK on youth employment, unemployment and inactivity rates


