


This note summarises employment, unemployment and economic Inactivity sourced from the Labour Force Survey for Scotland and the UK. These are classed as National Statistics.

This release follows the ONS monthly release of Regional Labour market Statistics in the UK

This month data are presented for the 3 months to October 2019, compared with the quarter before (May to July 2019) and compared with a year before (Aug to Oct 2018). Please note percentage point changes are based on unrounded data.



Employment rate (16-64 years) (%)

The employment rate in Scotland was 74.5 per cent. This is 0.4 percentage points down on the quarter and 0.5 percentage points down on the year.

The UK employment rate was 76.2 per cent. This is no change on the quarter and 0.4 percentage points up on the year.




The unemployment rate in Scotland was 3.7 per cent. This is 0.3 percentage points down on the quarter and 0.1 percentage points down on the year.

The UK unemployment rate was 3.8 per cent. This is no change on the quarter and 0.3 percentage points down on the year.



Unemployment rate (16 years and above) (%)






