SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1931. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly be submitted.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1931 comprised 2,681 sailing vessels, 2,037 motor vessels, 799 steam drifters, 2 steam mussel dredgers, 32 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 338 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,889 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,873,208, as against 5,969 vessels and £4,062,548 in 1930. In addition 299 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 24,024 (of whom 5,807 were crofter fishermen and 896 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 24,323 (including 5,952 crofter fishermen and 813 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 61,033, as against 66,167 in 1930.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,173,362 cwts., valued at £3,661,982, besides shell-fish valued at £91,920, as against 6,199,733 cwts., £4,177,775 and £104,399 respectively in 1930. In addition 735,831 cwts., valued at £256,682, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 887,458 cwts. and £367,777 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 5,909,193 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £4,010,584, as compared with 7,087,191 cwts. and £4,649,951 in 1930. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 2,344,141 cwts., valued at £1,128,005 against 3,408,278 cwts. and £1,466,965.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 626,854 barrels (of which 494,952 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,590,088, against a total of 953,461 barrels valued at £2,362,074 in 1930. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 427,855 cwts., valued at £918,448, as against 537,627 cwts. and £1,122,120 in 1930.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 484,608 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 1,493 barrels ungutted, and 87,797 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 798,308½ barrels, 3,908 barrels, and 118,023 crans respectively in 1930, and 195,075 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of other kinds, 13,588 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, and 2,302 cwts. of sprats iced and sprinkled, as against 245,925 cwts., 13,728 cwts., and 3,990 cwts. respectively in 1930.
