Foreword

Fish landed.—The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 5,876,220 cwt. valued at £12,867,593, compared with 5,741,135 cwt. and £11,890,424 in 1956. The value of shell fish landed was £583,186 as against £509,159 in 1956. In addition 109,505 cwt. of wet fish valued at £259,391 and shell fish valued at £78 were landed by Belgian, Danish, Faroese, German, Dutch, Irish Republican, Icelandic and Swedish fishing vessels as against 118,320 cwt. valued at £257,617 of wet fish and shell fish valued at £207 in the previous year, making a grand total of 5,985,725 cwt. valued with shell fish at £13,710,248 compared with 5,859,455 cwt. and £12,657,407 in 1956. Herring landed by British vessels contributed 1,648,720 cwt. valued at £1,640,291 as against 1,902,085 cwt. and £1,850,135 in 1956, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 4,115,844 cwt. valued at £11,133,115 compared with 3,750,855 cwt. and £9,973,041 in 1956. Foreign fishing vessels landed 29,396 cwt. of herring compared with 31,679 cwt. in 1956 and 74,574 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 81,176 cwt. in the previous year.

Fish cured.—The total quantity of herring cured, kippered, etc., amounted to 217,540 barrels (of which 121,902 were kippered and 54,339 pickle cured) valued after cure at £2,512,107, compared with a total of 237,227 barrels at £2,506,575 in 1956. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or canning amounted after cure to 205,157 cwt. valued at £1,566,348 as against 265,100 cwt. and £2,215,219 in 1956.

Fishing fleet.—The Scottish fishing fleet in 1957 comprised 164 steam trawlers, 28 motor trawlers, 3 steam liners, 2,892 motor vessels and 138 sail vessels, a total of 3,225 vessels compared with 3,304 vessels in 1956.

Fishermen.—The number of Scottish fishermen was 11,623 (of whom 1,489 were crofter fishermen and 1,151 were partially employed in fishing) as against 11,702 (including 1,540 crofter fishermen and 1,154 partially employed) in the previous year.

Explanatory Notes

Fishery Districts and Creeks

There were changes in the composition of certain fishery districts as from 1st January 1957 and the revised list is as follows :—

The old district of Helmsdale was merged with the Lossiemouth and Wick districts and Tarbert was merged with Campbeltown.

Within each district the composition and nomenclature of the creeks were revised, also from 1st January 1957, and Table 23 gives the new list of creeks.

Classification of squids

In the tables for 1954 and earlier years, squids have been classified as demersal fish. It was decided in view of the zoological classification of squids as members of the mollusc group that it was more appropriate for statistical purposes to classify them as shell fish. Effect has been given to that decision in the tables from 1955.
