FOREWORD

Fish Landed. The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 6,236,492 cwt. valued at £15,962,410 compared with 5,861,140 cwt. valued at £14,704,255 in 1963. The quantity of shell fish landed was 215,932 cwt. valued at £1,589,141 compared with 200,174 cwt. valued at £1,364,305 in 1963. In addition 171,429 cwt. of wet fish valued at £559,192 and 6 cwt. of shell fish valued at £44 were landed by Belgian, Danish, Faroese, German, Irish Republican, Netherlands, Norwegian, Polish and Swedish fishing vessels as against 176,921 cwt. of wet fish and 4 cwt. of shell fish valued at £553,824 and £23 respectively in 1963, making a grand total of 6,407,921 cwt. of wet fish valued at £16,521,603 (1963, 6,038,061 cwt. valued at £15,258,079) and 215,938 cwt. of shell fish valued at £1,589,185 (1963, 200,178 cwt. valued at £1,364,328). Herring landed by British vessels amounted to 1,578,655 cwt. valued at £1,958,493 as against 1,567,114 cwt. and £1,931,216 in 1963, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 4,208,500 cwt. valued at £13,830,718 compared with 3,648,424 cwt. valued at £12,583,523 in the previous year. Foreign fishing vessels landed 65,965 cwt. of herring compared with 46,822 cwt. in 1963, and 97,476 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 121,420 cwt. in 1963.

Fish Processed. The quantity of herring kippered, redded or canned was 219,226 crans, valued after process at £3,123,052 compared with 213,191 crans valued at £3,029,291 in 1963. In addition 17,791 barrels of herring valued at £114,725 were pickle-cured as against 29,943 barrels and £178,996 in 1963. Of other kinds of fish, the quantity processed, chiefly by smoking or canning, amounted after process to 208,607 cwt. valued at £2,109,440 as against 226,463 cwt. and £2,144,220 in 1963.

Fishing Fleet. The Scottish fishing fleet at 31st December 1964 comprised 9 steam trawlers, 122 motor trawlers over 80 ft., 2,772 other motor vessels and 44 sail vessels, a total of 2,947 vessels compared with 2,981 vessels in 1963.

Fishermen. The total number of Scottish fishermen at 31st December 1964 was 10,249 of whom 2,068 (including 916 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing. The number of fishermen at 31st December 1963 was 10,527 of whom 2,238 (including 991 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing.

United Kingdom Statistics. For convenient reference United Kingdom statistics are shown in Table I. Statistics in all other Tables relate solely to Scotland.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Fishing Vessels

Unless otherwise stated, fishing vessels are shown in registered lengths.

Shrimps and Cockles

From 1st January 1962 the landings of shrimps and cockles have been recorded separately, instead of being included with "other shell fish" as previously.

Classification of Squids

In the tables for 1954 and earlier years, squids were classified as demersal fish. It was decided in view of the zoological classification of squids as members of the mollusc group that it was more appropriate for statistical purposes to classify them as shell fish. Effect has been given to that decision in the tables from 1955.

THIS 48 page Digest is prepared half-yearly by the Scottish Statistical Office, St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh, in collaboration with the Statistics Divisions of Government Departments. Apart from the more obvious statistics it includes information on capital expenditure and cost and proceeds of the nationalised fuel industries, road and canal transport, local authorities' income and expenditure, inland revenue duties, civil and licensing courts and the weather.

The wide scope of the Digest makes it of value to industrialists, business executives, economists, journalists and all who are interested in the social economy of Scotland. A feature of the Digest is the quarterly Index of Industrial Production giving a measure of the changes since 1948 in the volume of output of a wide range of Scottish industries.

The statistical information is arranged under the following headings.

INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY
