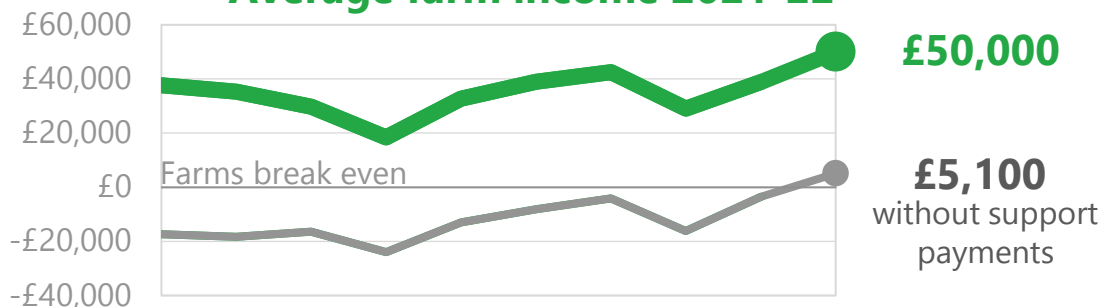


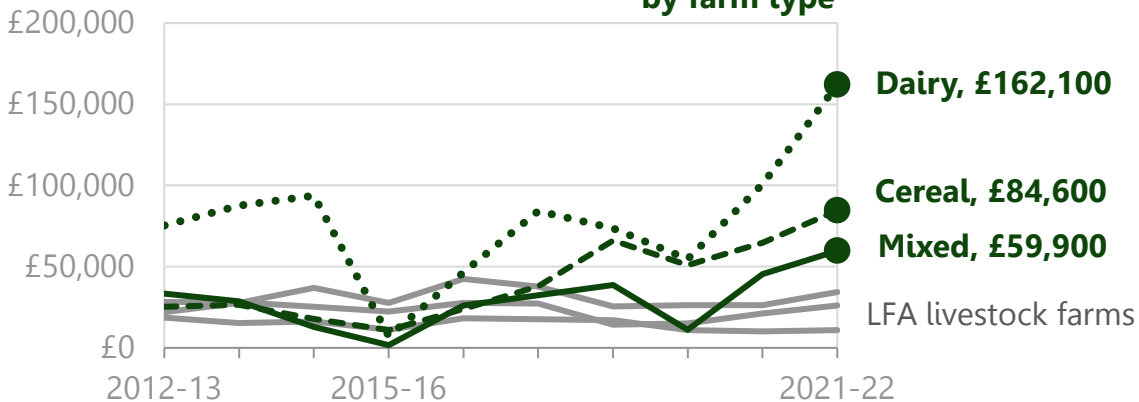


Scottish Farm Business Income 2021-22

by farm type



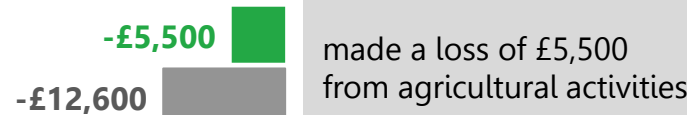
In 2021-22 the average farm...

received £39,100 in direct payments

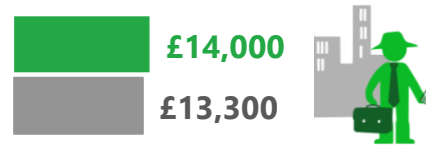


made a profit of £6,000 from diversified activities like renting or energy



made a loss of £5,500 from agricultural activities

received £14,000 from off-farm income, such as second jobs (in addition to their farm income)



increased in net worth (assets minus debt)



In 2021-22 more farms could afford to pay the MAW to unpaid labour



Farm business income measures farm profit (income from farming, diversification and support payments, minus costs) available to people who draw money from the business. Estimates cover commercial sized farms that receive support payments and do not cover horticulture, poultry, or pig farms. Farm types are based on the how much output is from the enterprises on each farm. Values are adjusted for inflation. MAW is the minimum agricultural wage, £8.86 per hour.
